Impact of a multi-modal allergen immunotherapy (SCIT) education and training program for primary care nurses at VA Connecticut (VACT)

Problem



Limited availability for SCIT patient services at VACT

SCIT poses risk of anaphylaxis

Major gaps in anaphylaxis knowledge among nurses and physicians

Population

23 VACT RNs 1 specialty clinic 9 PC clinics



12 RNs trained virtually 11 RNs trained in-person

Results

4-month cycle






